## 6 <u>Diocesan Board of Education</u>

The new board will comprise a maximum of 22 members: - in addition to the Bishop of Oxford, there could be 2 members of the Bishop's senior staff, plus a further 1 nominated directly by the Bishop, and up to 8 people coopted on the basis of their experience and skills in schools and our work. The Board is currently chaired by the Bishop of Buckingham.

The remaining 10 members will be elected by Diocesan Synod from the Archdeaconries as follows:

- Berkshire Archdeaconry 3 members: 1 of whom must be a member of Diocesan Synod, 1 must be Lay and 1 must be Ordained
- Buckinghamshire Archdeaconry as for Berkshire
- Dorchester Archdeaconry as for Berkshire
