- First draft budget presented to Synod in June, with share allocation to each deanery
- Deaneries are expected to agree allocation of share to parishes/ benefices by the autumn
- Final budget and Common Vision expenditure plans presented to November Synod for approval

What's happening Nationally (Parish Share)?

2022 v. 2021 year to date:

All Dioceses

- Average change in year to date cash receipts for 2022 vs 2021:
 +2.9%
- ② (Highest diocesan change: +19.1%, Lowest diocesan change: -5.2%)
- No. of dioceses receiving more cash in 2022 than in 2021: 30 out of 37 (81%)

Northern Province

- ☑ Average change in cash receipts for 2022 vs 2021: +3.4%
- No. of dioceses receiving more cash 2022 vs 2021: 6 out of 9 (67%)

Southern Province

- ☑ Average change in cash receipts for 2022 vs 2021: +2.8%
- No. of dioceses receiving more cash 2022 vs 2021: 24 out of 28 (86%)

What's happening Nationally (Parish Share)?

- 2022 v. 2019 year to date:
- ② Average change in year-to-date cash receipts for 2022 vs 2019: **-8.6%**
- ② (Highest diocesan change: +2.4%: one of four dioceses in positive nominal territory; Lowest
- diocesan change1: -21.3%,).
