Creation of a West end gallery with accessible WC and kitchenette underneath. Removal of 9 pews and all pew platforms, retained pews to be made movable. Provision of new heating system. Introduction of storage unit at East end of South aisle. Renewal of the Nave flooring in areas of timber pew platforms and aisle with tiles to match the existing. Alterations to the porch to create level access. Introduction of associated services and drainage. Introduction of new folding chairs to be stained to match existing timber throughout the interior. Regularisation of an interim faculty for the introduction of a new lighting system. All to be carried out in accordance with drawings and Specifications of Work by Christian Randall.
